INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING SPECIMENS AND APPARATUS

The teacher responsible for preparing specimens must ensure that candidates are provided with correct specimens and other materials as specified in these instructions. Claw hammer, labelled **D**

Sash Clamp, labelled **E**
